
ACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOUR GUIDELINES

SCHOOL HOLIDAY PROGRAM

- **Respect and support others** – speak with respect to others; use appropriate language; listen to others; use appropriate body language; be on time; use good manners; make amends by positive action; value each other.
- **Co-operate so that everyone can enjoy and learn** – include others, look after each other; use good manners; accept losing; encourage others; be honest.
- **Act in a manner that is safe for ourselves and others** – move with care and safety; put things away carefully; use equipment correctly and safely; follow procedures when walking and travelling by bus and public transport.
- **Sort out problems** – find solutions which do not involve physical contact; try to work out our problems ourselves; solve problems in a fair and reasonable manner; negotiate; listen to others; ask a youth worker for help.
- **Bullying - threats, verbal or physical - will NOT be tolerated under any circumstances.**
- **Participants should remain in the view of Youth Workers; especially on excursions.**
- **When at the Drop-in Centre – rules are displayed and must be followed.**
- **Specific rules will be explained to you on outdoor activities, excursions, bus and public transport.**
